Letter from the Pastor-Kevin Young, C.L.P.

Congregation and friends of 1st Presbyterian Church Finleyville;

The U.S. Supreme Court recently ruled that same-sex marriage is now legal in all 50 states. This is a defining moment for our nation!

Long before our government came into existence, Almighty God, the creator of all, created marriage. God is clear about the definition of marriage in His Holy Word: "Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh" (Genesis 2:24).
